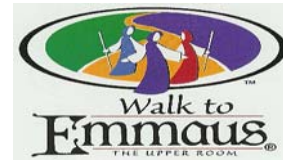

### A Few Thoughts from Your Spiritual Director

Here are some "STORMS OF LIFE" from the past week or two. A church member diagnosed with breast cancer and diabetes. Another member's sister diagnosed with cancer. Another member totaled the family van when he hit stray cow on the highway. A close friend going through separation from husband with a divorce pending. A drunk driver collided with a pickup another member was driving. Still another member's father diagnosed with pancreatic cancer. A former member's wife taken to the hospital early with breathing difficulties. My dad taken to the hospital in Michigan with an apparent heart attack, and admitted to Hospice. And all of this, not to mention the national tragedies of hurricanes, world tragedies of war and terrorist bombings. Gee Whiz, I seem to be summarizing the local, national, and world news. And none of it seems good. Well let me put this scenario into a spiritual context. We all are in some kind of "STORM OF LIFE". We, (God's disciples), are out on the open sea in a boat that is being tossed about wildly by a storm stronger than we've ever seen before, we are terrified, and we can see on the horizon that there are many more storms following the one we are in. The Bible tells us that Jesus, the living Son of the Living God, is right there with us. He said He would never leave us or forsake us! And Jesus, at the appropriate time, stands up in the boat, and with the authority and power that created the heavens and the earth says to the storms: "PEACE BE STILL!", and we disciples say, "Who is this man that even the storms of life obey him?" Hurricane Rita, downgraded as it approached the Houston area and though there was still some damage, it was not as predicted. There were some Christians who were Praying Jesus' Words, "Peace Be Still", to Rita, in the name of Jesus, and Rita lost some of her fury. Now there are two ways you can understand this.
