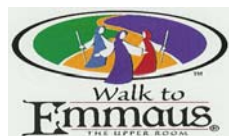

New Horizon Emmaus Community,
 Each month I've tried to clear-up some of the confusion that we see in Emmaus. I've talked about sponsorship, and all the anonymous servants throughout the Community that work behind the scenes. This month I want to talk about those you do see on the weekend ... the Team. Each January two very important committees are formed. The Nominations Committee is made up of a couple members from the Board and a few members from the Community. One of their jobs is to select Lay Directors for the upcoming weekends. The second committee, the Team Selection Committee, is also made up of members of the Board and the Community. Their job is to prayerfully select the Team God has chosen for that particular weekend. The Team Selection Committee, with input from the Weekend Lay Director and the Spiritual Director, selects a Team from towns across the New Horizon Emmaus Community. One-third of the Team consists of people who have never worked a Walk, one-third who have worked one or two Walks, and one-third who have worked 3 or more Walks. A Music Team and Clergy Team are also selected, along with at least two alternates for each position. Great emphasis is put into not having too many from any particular town or denomination. Once the list is finished, it goes before the entire board for final approval, and only then is the Weekend Lay Director able to start contacting the prospective Team. The Board assigns a Board Rep for the weekend. Then, once all the members of the Team have agreed to serve, the Team Selection Committee, with input from the Weekend Lay Director, meets again to assign Talks for the weekend. Some Talks must be given by certain people on the weekend (all the Grace Talks, Perseverance, Priorities, and Fourth Days) and some can be given by almost anyone. Board Reps only give Talks in last-minute emergencies, and it is preferred that Music Team doesn't give Talks. The intent of this process is to have a Team made up of diverse group of people from various towns and various denominations, with a mixture of Walk experience, giving Talks that will help them grow to be better leaders. Here are a few tips to help you be selected to work on a Team. First, make sure you have completed a current, up-to-date Member Data Sheet (available on the website.) If you move or your name changes, update your data sheet. When you work a Walk or give a Talk, update your data sheet. Second, be active in the Community so the Team Selection Committee will recognize your name when they see it on the list. Be an Angel during the weekend, make agape, go to the Community events. Third, and most importantly, if you haven't been asked to work a Walk and feel you should have been (remember, you have to wait a year from going on your Walk to work one, and then normally only one per year) let me or someone on the Board know. The data base is maintained regularly and is intended to be as accurate as possible, but we know it isn't perfect, especially in respect to the number of Walks you have worked. We are trying to clean-up the data base and keep it as accurate as possible, but it will take some time and help from each of you. So if you think you have been overlooked, let us know. But the bottom-line is this ... God puts together the perfect Team for every Walk. Time and time again we've seen people drop-off a Team or changes be made, and then realize that God put the right ones at the right places. I've seen people who weren't even on the original Team list, come to serve as a Resident Angel, then get moved to the inside Team, then give a Talk that absolutely blew the Pilgrims away. God has a way of getting the right people in the right places, sometimes in spite of us. And the result? The best Walk ever!
