New Horizon Emmaus Community,
So, what's your story?

I recently accompanied the Youth from our church on a Mission Trip to Denver where we spent 3 days working with the homeless at a rescue shelter. One of the men we worked with had only been in their recovery program for two weeks. But in that two week period God had made such a tremendous difference in his life. Not only was he now off the streets, he was working on-staff at the shelter and sharing his testimony to our kids. That's right, we went to share Christ with these homeless people, and here he was sharing with us what God had been doing in his life the past two weeks. It's much like working a Walk. How many times have we gone expecting to be Christ's servant to the Pilgrims, and instead we get our socks blessed off by them. Often we are asked to give Talks, and we feel we can't give a Talk. Maybe we think we aren't qualified, or we don't have a story to share. Maybe our life has been pretty normal, and we think no one wants to hear about me. Or we aren't comfortable talking in front of a group. I was that way ... I couldn't even get up and open a small meeting in prayer. Then the very first Walk I worked, I was asked to give a Talk. I wrote it and practiced it time after time. But each time I'd choke on my words, or lose my place, or maybe forget to breathe all together. How was I ever going to stand in front of that group and give that Talk? The day finally came, and I stood in that prayer room with the cross in my hand, as the Team and my wife prayed over me. Just as I walked down the hall from the Prayer Room to the Conference Room, I felt an arm around my shoulder and Jesus whispered in my ear "C'mon, let's go do this." As I stood at the podium, every word was perfect. I didn't stumble, I didn't stutter, I didn't lose my place. Every word was as if Jesus himself was speaking to those Pilgrims, which he was. He was just using my mouth and my voice to speak to them. Ever since that day I have never turned down an opportunity to share what Jesus Christ has done in my life. I've shared to individuals and to large groups. I've never worried about what to say, because now I know that it isn't really me speaking, but Christ speaking through me. That's all we've been asked to do ... go and share Jesus with others. And if you think you don't know what to say, that's okay. Just open your mouth and He'll give you the words. God can do amazing things if we'll just allow Him. He'll even use a poor, neglected homeless man to share with a group of young people ... but wait a minute ... doesn't that sound like a story from the Bible?
