A note from our Spiritual Director

GREETINGS TO THE SAINTS OF NEW HORIZONS EMMAUS COMMUNITY,

Paul started most of his Epistles by sending greetings to the "saints". I am sure most of the "saints" of that era understood his meaning. However, by our time, the word saint has taken on a different connotation. The practice of the Roman church of granting "sainthood" to men and women based on their life of service here on earth has led to some degree of confusion. The mistaken belief may come from statements like "that Sandy must be a saint to put up with Ron" (I am sure none of you really believe that, if you know me well!) Sainthood is granted to all that believe, because by faith in Jesus Christ we are first justified then He has sanctified us. God has saved us by faith and has set us apart (sanctified us) to do good works in His name! **Romans 7:4, So, my brothers, you also died to the law through the body of Christ, that you might belong to another, to him who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit to God.** NIV In the OT, God made a promise of sanctification to the Israelites (Ezekiel 36:22-25) that basically is the same as in Romans 7:4> He has set us apart to do His good works. The Israelites took this as an exclusive right, not an inclusive command. They, therefore, believed themselves to be chosen by God as the only group to whom was speaking. God apparently intended them to be a priesthood unto the world (Exodus 19:6). This promise is fulfilled in the New Covenant. We are made Holy so the nations will know our God. Our sanctification is to glorify God and draw others to Jesus Christ. Therefore, this man-made instrument called an Emmaus community is to be known and used to bear fruit to our Lord.
