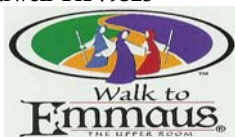

Greetings to the Saints of New Horizons Community:

J.I. Packer in his book *Evangelism and the Sovereignty of God* writes man is tempted to make human responsibility the exclusive mode of action for salvation. We know that our responsibility to our Maker is a fact. God made us responsible moral agents and will not treat us otherwise. We live under His law and thus must answer for our actions. We have a responsibility for making the Gospel known. So the thought that the responsibility of both the preacher and the hearer is a serious one!
