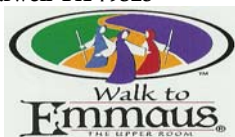

## A note from our Spiritual Director

Greetings to the Saints of New Horizons Community:

What is Evangelism?

Last month I wrote that all should evangelize, but what is evangelism? Most might say that is a foolish question, but is it? The confusion might be that we define evangelism, not in terms of the message, but related to the effect produced. The Archbishops committee of 1918 defined evangelism: "To evangelize is to present Jesus Christ...so that men shall come to put their trust in God through Him, to accept Him as savior, and serve Him as king..." Thus to evangelize is to present a specific message about Jesus Christ. It is not to present the thoughts and sayings of a good man and a brilliant teacher to make people feel good about their life. It is not evangelism to present Jesus as a subject for comparative study. It is not even to present the truth of His saving work. It is to present Jesus as the Christ, the living savior and our reigning lord!

Paul said to Timothy, **1 Tim 2:5-6** For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, 6 who gave Himself a ransom for all...and Peter added this to the message... **1 Peter 3:18** For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God... He thus, is according to His own claim: **John 14:6**... the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

He is to be proclaimed as the Savior, the one who came into the world to save sinners and who became a "curse" for us. Is there any evangelism without this message? The last part of the definition is that we are to summon men and women to accept Jesus for all He is and to then serve Him as King in the fellowship of His universal church: to worship Him, to witness for Him, and to work for Him.

Recently, I so focused on the concept of evangelism being man's work, that I forgot that the giving of faith and the drawing to God was the work of the Holy Spirit! **John 6:44** No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him... I felt that all my effort was wasted because I did not see the result I desired. I had to be reminded by the Holy Spirit that my part in evangelism is not defined by the result! It is only defined by the message I present!
