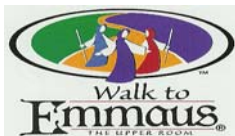

Thoughts From Our Spiritual Director

It is an honor to be elected as your New Horizon Community spiritual director. For those who do not know me I want to give you a biographical sketch of whom I am.
