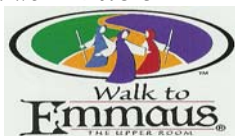

What's in a Name?

What's in a name? what's in God's name? what is God's name?

The word 'god' merely tells us what He is, but no Who. A god is a diety, an object of worship, In the case of our God, He is the Supreme Diety, worthy of all praise and worship. But that still does not tell us much about Him.

The name Jehovah means "self-existent one" and occurs many times in the Bible, but is best explained in Exodus 3:14. Here God speaks to Moses from a burning bush commanding him to go to Pharoah and demand the release of the sons of Israel. Moses answers God saying, "Behold, I am going to the sons of Israel, and I shall say to them, "the God of your fathers has sent me to you. ' Now they may say to me, 'what is His name?' What shall I say to them?"

God answered Moses and said, "I Am Who I am." God continued, "Say to the sons of Israel, I AM has sent me to you."

Elohim, another name used to denote the God of Israel was Elohim. It occurs 2,700 times in the Bible and means, God the strong One, the Almighty, the powerful God. Elohim appears in the first line of the original Hebrew text where it says, "in the beginning God (Elohim) created the heavens and the earth" (Gen.1:1).God, the all-powerful One, Who alone could create sunsets over waters, hills bursting with waterfalls, green-velvet valleys, snowflakes in moonlight, iridescent birds, darting fish, furred creatures, fearfully and wonderfully-made man.
