## From The Community Spiritual Director

### What's in a Name?

#### 3rd of 5 articles

What's in a name? What's in God's name? What is God's name? Jehovah- Jireh. The name Jehovah is often used in combination with other descriptive words to form a compound name which shows us various facets of God's personality. After God performed the miraculous, He asked what seemed like an impossible sacrifice from Abraham. One day when Isaac had become a young man, God asked Abraham to sacrifice his promised son on the altar. There is no indication Abraham ever questioned God. In willing obedience, he took Isaac to the mountain, tied him on a pile of wood and raised his hand to kill him. At that moment an angel intervened, telling him to stop. It had all been a test to see how much Abraham trusted and feared God. Immediately, Abraham raised his eyes and saw a ram caught by its horns in a thicket. He sacrificed the ram instead of his son and called the name of the place Jehovah-Jireh, which means the Lord will provide. (Gen. 22:14). Yes, God will provide our material needs, the air we breathe, the clothes we wear, the food we eat and most wonderful of all, He provides His Lamb, Jesus as a means of salvation. Jehoval -Ropeheka. Not only does God provide atonement for our sins, but He provides healing for our bodies as well. Do you remember the story of the people of Israel when they camped at Marah? The water was so bitter they could not drink it, and they began complaining loudly. Moses gave them an object lesson when he cut down a tree and threw it into the waters. At that moment God healed the waters and declared unto the people that He is Jehovah-Ropheka, the God who heals not only bitter waters, but angry, complaining, bitter people as well (Ex. 15:26) He is still the God who heals. He can heal instantly in a miraculous way, He can heal slowly, or if He chooses, He can heal through medicine. Despite the way in which we are healed, it is God who is the Source of all healing.
