What's in a Name?

What's in a name? What's in God's name? what is God's name?

Jehovah-Nissi. This beautiful name means a banner, a rod, a standard. The children of Israel were at war with the Amalekites. As long as Moses held up the rod. The Israelites advanced, but when he lowered it, the Amalekites gained ground. Finally Joshua and Hur, his helpers, had to hold up his hands and give him a stone to sit upon so that he could endure to the end of the battle, when at last the battle was done and the Israelites had won, Moses built an altar and names it.
