A Note from our Community LD

Dear Community,
Several years ago the movie 'Pay It Forward' came out. In it, a young boy does a good deed for someone and instead of asking it to be paid back, he tells his recipient to *pay it forward*. The idea of paying it forward is just that – if you pay a good deed done to you forward to three people and they in turn 'pay it forward' to three more and so on, in a couple of months, over four million people will have been touched by that one decision to 'pay it forward'. Isn't that kind of what Jesus did for us when He died for our sins? He 'paid it forward' over 2000 years ago and since then untold millions of people have been recipients of the grace and forgiveness of God by that one act. My pastor talked about God's expanding grace in his sermon yesterday and compared it to a crack in a windshield.
