You will also be able to view your Walk experience and contact the Database Administrator (Debbie Annen) with any corrections that need to be made. So, we are asking all Community members to please go online to

<http://nhec.inetmember.com> where you will be asked to enter your email address (if your email has changed recently you will need to enter your OLD email address) and the INITIAL or FIRST TIME password of 'Decolores' (be sure to cap the D in Decolores). You will be prompted to change your password once you log on. From there, at the top of the page (you will have to use the top scroll bar to scroll down slightly); you will find the menu item You and Community. Under "You" please verify that all information we have is correct. If it is not, then you can change what needs to be changed. If under your 'Experience' there is an issue, you will be able to write a note to explain/correct your information, which will be sent to Debbie where she will make those corrections. Only the Database Administrator can make changes to your Walk Experience. All contact information is changed by you. I invite you to look around in the database. I think you'll see why the Board is so pleased and excited about this wonderful tool. We plan on reviewing this at our April Community meeting.
