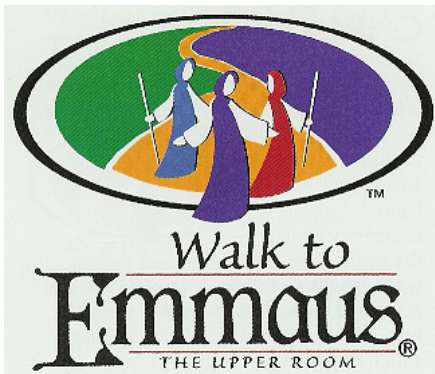
#### **HELP WANTED:**
