

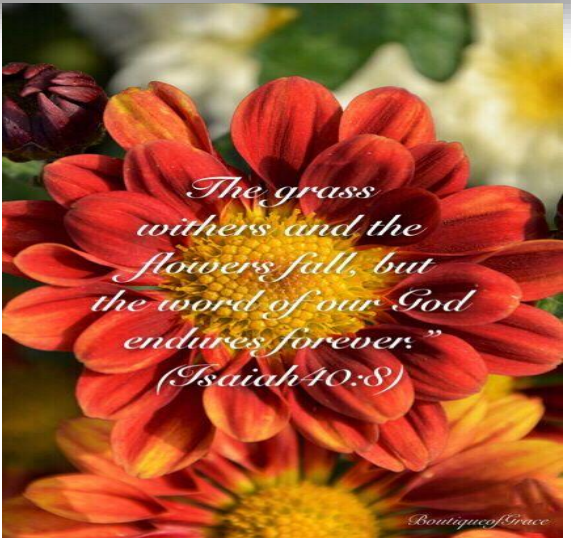

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRAYER VIGIL

Go to our NEW Database @

<https://www.ministrymanager.upperroom.org>

Login or Sign up. (FYI: This does not work in Internet Explorer.) Then it will take you to a page that says upcoming events. Scroll down the page until you see "Prayer Vigil" on the right; click on "My Prayer Times" if you are signed up, it will show your dates & times right under that. If it not, click on "Upcoming Prayer Vigils" & then click on "Read More." It will show a new page with the date of the next Walk; highlight the Walk #line (next to the box date) and it will direct you to the sign-up times page. Scroll down to find the open time slot you would like, hit select, and it will place your name there with the word "unassigned", don't worry it is in there, the Pray Vigil Coordinator will take care of the rest. Now click home page at the top, then scroll down and on the right under "Prayer Vigil", the times you just selected should be showing.

A NOTE FROM THE COMMUNITY LAY DIRECTOR

My commute to and from work recently has been one of quiet. I've not turned on the radio for a while enjoying the quiet instead. Today, I reached over and turned on the radio and "Extravagant" by Bethel was playing. The song describes Jesus's love as not making sense, a love we can't comprehend, given freely, unthinkable. It's a love that cannot be bought, but only received. It's a love that can't be quenched. It's a love that is meant to be lived and a love that is meant to be shared.

How do we live the extravagant love of God?

John 13:34~ I am giving you a new commandment, that you [a]love one another. Just as I have loved you, so you too are to love one another"
