A NOTE FROM THE COMMUNITY LAY DIRECTOR

Blessings all,

I was honored last night to have dinner with the Emmaus Board and to receive a Word from a great man of God, Brother Nathan Harvey. That Word has been stirring in me the past 24 hours. The Word he shared was much more detailed and elaborate but the part I wanted to share with the community this month is regarding our tongues.

Mathew 12: 34-37 says ***"Out of the overflow of the heart, the mouth speaks. The good man brings good things out of the good stored up in him, and the evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in him. But I tell you that men will have to give an account on the day of judgment for every careless word they have spoken. For by your words, you will be acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned."***

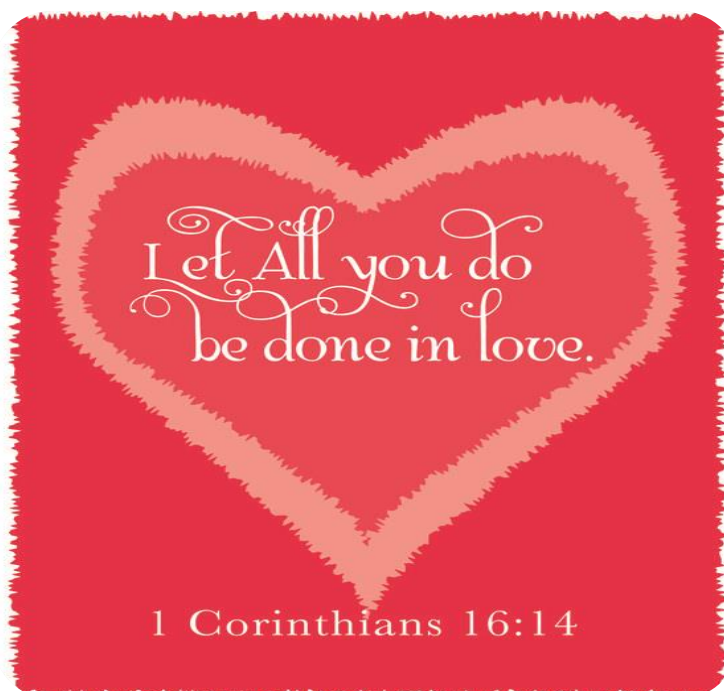
I am so convicted by that. If I believe the Bible and I do, there is a reason that we are going to be accountable for every word. Every word, whether spoken out of love, out of resentment, out of bitterness, I will be accountable for every word. We are told that the tongue holds the power of life and death. I pray that my tongue will speak life and that each of us in the brotherhood of faith will be quick to speak encouragement and love, and, wise to speak instruction when guided by Holy Spirit and the Word to do so.
