GOLD is mention 417 times in the Bible.

Gold played an important part in the construction of the tabernacle and temple. The ark was overlaid with gold and many of the utensils were made of gold, as well as part of the structure itself (Exod 25:11-39; 1 Kings 6:20-35). Gold's symbolic association with royalty made it natural choice for the house of the King of kings and the instruments used in worshipping him.
