Greetings Community! I want to say a congratulations to all of you who are celebrating graduations this month, whether from kindergarten or college. These are markers in the lives of our Emmaus family that need to be recognized.

I read a comment the other day that said, "The enemy wants you in your feelings."

When we are in our feelings, the enemy can keep us out of our purpose. I don't know about you, but I can find myself in my feelings from time to time. The word tells us in Proverbs 3:5 that our feelings (or hearts) can't be trusted: Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. We are called to live by faith, not feelings 2 Corinthians 5:7 We live by faith not by sight. Noah gives us a great lesson in how not to live by feelings: He was building an ark because God was going to send rain. Noah was old, and he spent many years building his ark.
